**About IBANGS:** <u>The International Behavioural and Neural Genetics Society</u> was established in 1996 to promote growth of research in the field of neural behavioral genetics and behavioral neuroscience. The society has academic and corporate members worldwide that study the basis of a wide range of behaviors and brain disorders together with the underlying neuronal mechanisms using diverse species.

For the past 25 years the <u>annual meeting</u> has attracted ~175 participants drawn from multiple countries and included a scientific program of plenary lectures, symposia, selected talks, award ceremonies and poster sessions.

For the first time in 2025, IBANGS comes to the Southern Hemisphere, with a significant increase in attendees from the Asia-Pacific region expected.
