About IBANGS

The International Behavioural and Neural Genetics Society was established in 1996 to promote and facilitate the growth of research in the field of neural behavioral genetics. The society has members worldwide that study the genetic basis of a wide range of behaviors and brain disorders together with the underlying neuronal mechanisms using diverse species. The ultimate goal is to elucidate the molecular pathways through which genes together with the environment affect behavior.

For 20 years the annual meeting has attracted 100-150 participants drawn from multiple countries and included a scientific program of plenary lectures, symposia, selected talks, and poster sessions. The IBANGS 2019 Annual Meeting will be held at the University of Edinburgh, [School of Informatics](#) which has ample exhibit and meeting space (shown in the photos below), ideal for conferences such as ours.
